

# WESTERN INTERNATIONAL PISTOL LEAGUE

## 2019 – 2020 WIPL Season Schedule

Hi to all pistol shooters! Yes, it is time to think about WIPL again. If you have not tried it yet - well come out and join in!

The first competition will be held Sunday September 29, 2019 at Port Coquitlam & District Hunting & Fishing Club. This year again the November through March matches will be held indoors at the Langley and Abbotsford clubs, then back to Port Coquitlam for the final April match. As in the past, to make the League available to more competitors, we are opening it up to everyone Province-wide in the form of postal matches.

Each match will have two events: Standard Pistol (i.e. .22 cal) and Centre Fire/Sport Pistol. Both are run back-to-back with relaxed International Shooting Sport Federation (ISSF) rules. You can use any caliber in Centre Fire up to 45 cal. Use what you have (.45, .38, .40 cal, 9mm, whatever). If you don't have a Centre Fire pistol, you can still shoot along with the Centre Fire shooters using your .22 cal pistol in the Sport Pistol classification. This shoots the same targets - just gets classed with other sport pistol shooter's scores.

### How does it work?

- You can enter Standard Pistol, or Centre Fire/Sport Pistol, or both. Please RSVP to notices.
- There are eight match dates, the top five match scores for each event class define your aggregate total.
- The cost is \$30.00 per event when pre-registering for the season or \$5.00 for a single event.
- Out of town Postal Shooters may enter for \$5.00 per event for the season.
- Awards will be given at the last WIPL match on May 3.
- The top three shooters in each Club will constitute that Club's Team(s).
- There will be top gun status awarded for Standard Pistol, Centre Fire, and Sport Pistol, along with most improved and best rookie shooter (based on Standard Pistol scores) at the last match.

Anyone having paid for an event for the full season or attending five of the eight matches listed below and submitting a minimum of five scores in a single event will be eligible to receive a draw prize.
